3.5	<ul> <li>NPC Parking Management in Ashmere</li> <li>Many residents are upset with the new parking restrictions put in place in Ashmere, while they have been welcomed by others. <ul> <li>A lengthy discussion concluded that:</li> <li>Parking management is in the TP1 document and rent charge deeds that residents sign as part of their purchase/occupation</li> <li>The parking strategy is being rolled out across the whole of Whitecliffe</li> <li>Countryside and RMG are meeting on 26 July to discuss suspending enforcement on estate roads until next steps are agreed and communicated</li> <li>The communication to residents should be sent with a map explaining who owns what road and what the parking restrictions are/will be.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	RMG/Countr yside
3.6	Blue Badge parking A policy document was issued but HC will review with reference to private roads and visitor bays not being near enough to where you are visiting. (post meeting note – a revised policy is attached with these minutes)	НС
3.8	Shepherd Neame pub EDC has begun early-stage discussions with Shepherd Neame to understand their programme for the delivery of the pub, and how they can support this. The 2019 planning permission has now expired so a new application will need to be submitted.	EDC
3.9	Motorbikes accessing Northern footpath This was raised by Bellway's sales representative. "A" frame barriers which would stop bikes cannot be installed as this would stop access for wheelchairs and double buggies. HC has advised that this activity should be reported to the Police.	Note
